

PRINCE2 AGILE® PRACTITIONER – 3 DAYS

This course will show you how you can combine the product focus of agile with the project management governance of PRINCE2® in order to provide a holistic approach to the project as a whole.

TARGET GROUP

- Anyone who wants to know how PRINCE2 could be tailored to fit into an agile setting.
- Everyone who wishes to know more about agile ways of working e.g. Scrum, Kanban, Lean Startup, Cynefin and many agile techniques in a project context
- Anyone who wants to extend their PRINCE2 certification-level with an agile project management certification
- Project managers, PMO managers, program managers or team managers who either is using agile in a project context or are encountering external suppliers using agile

PREREQUISITES

A prerequisite for taking the PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner exam is that you hold any of the following exams

- PRINCE2 Foundation
- Project Management Professional® (PMP)
- Certified Associate in Project Management® (CAPM)
- IPMA Levels A, B, C and D® (Certified Projects Director)

If you don't have a PRINCE2 Foundation qualification, we recommend that you familiarize you with the PRINCE2 manual before you start reading the PRINCE2 Agile manual.

Our experience is, that if you don't have fresh knowledge of PRINCE2, it would be recommendable to repeat the PRINCE2 method. During the course, we will do some overall brush-up of the PRINCE2-metod.

We also recommend delegates that have taken their PRINCE2 Foundation using the 2005 manual, to invest in the PRINCE2, 2009 manual.

It is **not** a prerequisite that you have knowledge of agile frameworks, methods, behaviors, and techniques.

BENEFITS FROM TAKING THIS COURSE

Upon completion of this PRINCE2 Agile practitioner course, you will be able to

- Understand how PRINCE2 can be tailored to work in agile context and how PRINCE2 can add structure and minimize risk in an agile project management setting.
- How you can identify agile behaviors in your organization and how agile roles could be combined with PRINCE2-roles.
- How to use PRINCE2 tolerances to configure PRINCE2 in an agile project management environment
- Integrate agile frameworks, behaviors, concepts, and techniques with PRINCE2 in order to increase the probability of successful projects.

TRAINING METHOD

To us, the most important thing is that you can start practicing your newly acquired competencies the day after your PRINCE2 Agile practitioner course. That's why we deliver courses using the delegates live cases as much as we can. Our method consists of three steps. 1. Your pre-study reading the manual, 2. Study groups during the self-study period. 3. Classroom training: Presentations by trainer combined with as many exercises based on delegate's live projects as possible and discussions about tailoring.

Manual and materials are in English. Trainer is Danish-speaking and will be speaking Danish during the event.

EXAM

The PRINCE2 Agile practitioner exam is at the end of day 3. The exam is a 2½ hour open book, objective test, where you are permitted to bring your PRINCE2 Agile manual. The exam consists of 50 questions, structured in 5 groups, and you need 60% correct answers to pass the exam and get your certificate.

A prerequisite for the "PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner" exam and certificate is the PRINCE2 Foundation Exam or a PMI (PMP / CAPM) or IPMA (A, B, C, or D) certification.

- Tailoring guidance of the seven PRINCE2-processes in an agile environment
- Tailoring guidance of the seven PRINCE2-themes in an agile environment
- What are in agile concepts and in PRINCE2?
- Tools to assess how agile you risk being?
- Tailoring guidance of 26 PRINCE2 management products
- PRINCE2 Agile Practitioner Exam

DURATION AND PLAN

The course will be completed over 3 days with the exam on the 3rd day. It is optional if you wish to participate in the exam.

You should expect approx. 20-30 hours of preparation before the course days. This is assuming your PRINCE2 knowledge is up-to-date.

The extent of your own preparation before the course also depends on how much you know about agile approaches. You may thus need to acquire fundamentally knowledge of agile approaches. However, you

should be aware that the course contains introduction to agile methods with emphasis on Scrum, Kanban, Lean Startup and Cynefin.

The course is delivered over three days

The exam is held on the 3rd day of study at. 13:30 - 16:00
